# Photography COMPETITION

## **Rules & Guidelines**

- The competition is open to all current Faculty of Philosophy undergraduate students in the academic year 2022-2023.
- All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party.
- Entrants may submit up to 3 entries to the competition.
- All entries must be received before midnight on Monday 15th May 2023.
- Each entry should be submitted by email to [philundergrad@phil.cam.ac.uk](mailto:philundergrad@phil.cam.ac.uk) with the subject title 'Photography Competition', and the name, college, and university email address of the entrant in the body of the email. Multiple entries should be sent in separate emails.
- Photographs should be high resolution to allow for printing for display and should be submitted in jpeg, png, gif or tiff format.
- If the photograph(s) features recognisable people, the entrant is responsible for obtaining written consent for the image to be entered in the competition and to be published in all media as required by the Faculty of Philosophy as well as being displayed in the Faculty.
- Judges will select the winning work which, in their opinion, best meets the spirit of the competition. They will look at the composition, form, feel and impact of the image, observing the work as a whole, finding an emotion or connection that resonates with them. The judges' decisions are final.
- The results will be announced on or before Monday 22nd May 2023 and the winner and runners up will be contacted by email.
- The competition winner will win a £25 Love Cambridge voucher (accepted by 189 retailers in Cambridge, including shops, restaurants, cafes, leisure, health & beauty & more. See: [www.love-cambridge.com](http://www.love-cambridge.com)) and will have their work displayed in the Faculty. The two runners up will have their work displayed in the Faculty.
- Copyright for every submitted entry remains with the entrant.
- The winner and runners-up will have their work displayed in the Faculty of Philosophy. These will be specially printed for display at no expense to the entrant. By entering the competition, entrants give permission for their work to be displayed in the Faculty.
- By submitting a photograph to the competition, all entrants grant the Faculty of Philosophy, free of charge, the non-exclusive right to publish their entries on the Faculty website, social media sites, or other Faculty publications and communications, including online, and to exhibit the artwork anywhere within the Faculty.
