- 1. In what sense, if any, did Wittgenstein think that meaning is use? Was he right?
- 2. What conclusion was Wittgenstein attempting to establish with the Doodle Argument (*PI*, §175)? Was he successful?
- 3. Describe and assess Wittgenstein's account of aspect-perception.
- 4. What, if anything, did the later Wittgenstein think was wrong with the picture theory?
- 5. Describe and assess Wittgenstein's criticism of solipsism in the *Blue Book*.
- 6. Describe and assess Wittgenstein's *Blue Book* treatment of the idea that the meaning of a word is an associated mental image.
- 7. EITHER: (A) What, if anything, is special about performatives? Answer with reference to Austin.
 - OR: (B) How do illocutionary acts differ from other things that we do with words? How can they go wrong? Answer with reference to Austin.
- 8. Describe and assess Austin's attack on sense data.
- 9. Does Anscombe offer a satisfactory account of how to distinguish an expression of intention from a prediction?
- 10. 'It can be quite natural to think that events which are characterisable as intentional are a certain natural class, "intentional" being an extra property which a philosopher must try to describe' (ANSCOMBE). Does Anscombe have a plausible alternative to this view?
