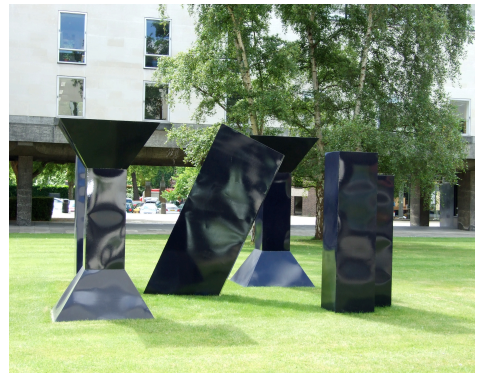

- Printers: *Phil_FindMe* printer, copier, multi feed scanners (**Grad Centre**: Konica C3351 - A4 black & white plus colour, double-sided printing and **Library**: Konica C284e - A4/A3 black & white plus colour printing)
- In Library: PC and 2 x Library catalogue search computers plus the printer
