- 5 Is it possible that you are a brain in a vat?
- 6 **Either** (*a*) Is there a standpoint from which the competing claims of different schemes of representation can be assessed?
 - **Or** (b) Is metaphysics possible?
- 7 **Either** (*a*) Is my thinking about my future the only reason for me to worry about the possibility of fission cases?
 - **Or** (b) 'The problem of personal identity over time is often stated in a way that favours some solutions over others.' Is it?

- 9 Space has three dimensions, time one. Is this significant?
- 10 Is knowing the mental properties of other beings any more problematic in principle than knowing their non-mental properties?
