1. 'Markets in women's reproductive labour are right in theory, but wrong in practice.' Discuss.
2. 'National boundaries are ethically significant, just not as ethically significant as global poverty.' Discuss.
3. What, if anything, do the old owe to the young?
4. EITHER (a) Are political liberals just comprehensive liberals in disguise?  
  
OR (b) Is Rawls's lack of concern for the views of unreasonable people unreasonable?
5. What does it mean to say that liberals have an atomistic view of persons? Is it true? If so, is it a problem for liberalism?
6. Is 'Is multiculturalism bad for women?' a good question to ask?
7. EITHER (a) 'Men and women are equal! Men and women are different!' Are these slogans contradictory?  
  
OR (b) What, if anything, is wrong with gendered norms of appearance and behaviour?
8. 'Pornographers, not anti-porn feminists, are the opponents of free speech.' Discuss.
9. EITHER (a) 'The class which is the ruling material force of society is at the same time its ruling intellectual force.' (Marx). Discuss.  
  
OR (b) 'Marx's theory of ideology portrays workers as the unwitting dupes of a bourgeois conspiracy, so we should reject his theory.' Discuss.
10. Are workers alienated under capitalism? Does it matter if they are?
