- 3 'Marx's theory of history is either implausible or not very distinctive.' Discuss.

- 5 What, if anything, do we owe people who do not yet exist?
- 6 **Either** (a) What is the best argument for the Difference Principle?
Or (b) 'A hypothetical agreement is not worth the paper it is written on.' Is this a fair criticism of Rawls?

- 8 Does Marx's theory of alienation rely on an implausible conception of human nature?
